Daily Operations

- Perform basic maintenance, troubleshooting and repairs on computing equipment and state of the art liquid immersion data center systems
- Conduct regular facility inspections and document findings
- Any other duties as assigned by management

- Organise and manage cabling infrastructure
- Assist with equipment upgrades and replacements
- Maintain clean and organized workspace following data center best practices

Warehouse Maintenance:

- Organize equipment and supplies
